

CALEDONIAN GAINS IN MIXED BONSPIEL

MOUNT HOPE, N. Y., Feb. 26—The New York Caledonian Curling Club No. 1 rink began defense of the Wicks Trophy championship today as the 10th annual St. Andrew's invitation mixed bonspiel started at the St. Andrew's Golf Club Ice Arena.

After drawing a first-round bye, the Caledonians, skipped by Ford D. (Dick) Cleaves, defeated Utica C. C., skipped by George McCarthy, 10-6, in their 10-end match.

Two Canadian rinks, Burlington (Ont.) Golf and Country Club and the Hamilton (Ont.) Thistle C. C., also entered the quarter-final round. They were joined by rinks from Schenectady Curling Club and the Nutmeg C. C. of Darien, Conn.

The bonspiel runs through Sunday afternoon when finals in the Wicks Trophy event and two consolation flights will be curled.
