

# HAMILTON ADVANCES TO FINAL IN CURLING

MOUNT HOPE, N. Y., Feb. 27—The Hamilton (Ont.) Thistle Curling Club rink reached the final round of the 10th annual St. Andrew's invitation mixed bonspiel tonight after defeating last year's winner in the quarter-final round earlier in the day.

The Thistles, skipped by Arthur Burns, needed only eight ends to win their semi-final, 16—4, from the No. 1 rink of the Nutmeg Curling Club of Darien, Conn., skipped by Jack Fowler, at the St. Andrew's Golf Club Ice Arena.

In a regulation 10-end match, Hamilton beat the defending Wicks Trophy champion, New York Caledonian C. C. No. 1 rink, skipped by Ford D. (Dick) Cleaves, 12—7, in the round-of-eight.
