I am pleased that you have agreed to serve on the GNCC nominating committee. This year our task will be quite easy since all of the current officers serve 2 year terms. The only business that I am aware that needs action at the Annual Meeting, is to appoint a USCA Director, since the term of Evelyn Nostrand will expire next April. Minutes of the June 6, 1996 meeting were accepted as read.

2 Brooms - Tues. Dec. 3 evening at Ardsley, daytime in Jan. (probably Thurs. 1/16 - 1st choice - or 1/9) at Nutmeg. 3 teams needed for each time. Committee needed to greet and arrange for food Dec. 3.

Empire State - Jan 23-26, same time as GNCC Women's Championship at Ardsley. 2 teams needed to go to Utica for Empires.

Women's Challenge - at Nutmeg 2/27-3/2, same weekend as Douglas at Ardsley.

GNCC Women's Championships - 8 to 10 teams are expected. A chairman is needed from among those who are not going to Empires. These are serious curlers who expect few frills. An entry fee of \$20 per team calls for a tight budget. (It is bound to run in the red.) Jean Murphy has arranged for Friday night's dinner to be held at her sister's in Briarcliff Manor. 3 simple breakfasts, lunches for purchase and the dinner must be arranged. Diane Mojo is head of officials. Jean Murphy will be competing.

President Murphy called upon Sandi Buchanan, Chair of the Nominating Committee, to present the proposed slate. The following names were presented:


