October 30, 1997

Pres. Murphy opened the meeting held at the Ardsley Curling Club at 8 pm.

Minutes of the April 26, 1997 Annual Meeting were read. Minutes of the April 26, 1997 Board Meeting were accepted as presented.

Treasurer's Report - Jean Glus reported 119 Ardwick pins on hand. Curlers paid and committed for this season: 8 Tuesday evening, 9 Thursday morning, 13 Associate members. 2 have asked to be removed from the roster: Artel and Heffner. A notice will be posted by Tuesday reminding people to sign up and pay dues. \$360 in dues has been received this week and there is a balance of \$963.96 in the Treasury.

Home Sports:

Daytime - Gail LaBrosse hopes to have enough people to use 2 sheets of ice. She will pursue prospects from list of new members.

Evening - Pam Siebert noted the game record book is missing. Forms need to be duplicated to be available when competition begins. The evening curlers' scramble will last 2 weeks. There are 23 curlers.

Lillie Baggett noted how important it is to follow up prospective members who come to the Open House and seem interested in joining.

Bonspiels:

2 Brooms - Jo Owens wanted committment from Lillie regarding dates way before we met this fall. After discussion, it was decided we'd like to host day, Friday Dec. 5 at 10 am and use Ardsley Clubhouse for Dutch Treat lunch (rather than a day when the club is unavailable). Monday evening, Jan 12, will be at Nutmeg. Lillie still has bill from Nutmeg for their event last year which is difficult to interpret and settle.

Jean Murphy would like to post a board listing all upcoming bonspiels. She mentioned some upcoming bonspiels that might be of interest and will post notices as they are received.

Prizes - Betty Steinemann showed a new version of the Clarke pin, which needs to be reordered for the '99 Empire States. It was decided to order these @ \$8 from Wayne Silversmith, rather than \$26.73 pins from Balfour. Betty noted there are still outstanding bills from '96-'97 submitted to the Ardsley Treasurer. Betty has list of all pins and events at which they're offered which she'll pass on to Norah Clarke, her replacement. Pam and Gail will give Norah lists of winners at end of this curling season.

Skips' Rep. - Mary Jean Keenan reported there has not be a skips' meeting. Pam tried to balance teams last year but had some complaints. She'll encourage rotation of positions played and put skips in control of their team's order of players. this year.

USWCA Rep. - Sarah Murphy represented Ardwicks at the Sept. 27 meeting in Falmouth, MA. It is the 50th anniversary of womens curling in the U.S.A. A list of USWCA events for '97-'98 was distributed. The 50th National Bonspiel will be Feb. 12-15 in Utica. Playdowns for the National take place Jan. 22-25 at Nutmeg. Free guard zone use at all USWCA events and implementation of new rules will be decided by a National Bonspiel Committee. Fundraisers for Olympic teams offer Christmas cards, pins, etc. It was noted the Senior Women's Bonspiel is the week after the Empire States in Medford, WI.

Publicity - Jean Glus continues to chair. Jean Murphy will submit article to "Duck Soup."

Empire States - Jan. 8-11 - Jean Murphy and Mary Jean will co-chair. Invitations must go out quickly. Jean can do much of this work rapidly by computer. Jean will research motels and Mary Jean will check on "An Evening" Dinner Theatre. The Kennys will host the Thursday night reception (heavy hors d'oeuvres) and a dinner will be at Jean's sister's home in Briarcliff. There will be a committee meeting Wed. Nov. 5 at 7 pm.

Turkey Trot - Lillie reported the committee consists of Kal and Kathy Sundaram, co-chairs, Laureen Paul, Patti Burns and Laurie Frees. It will take place only Sat. and Sun. of the Thanksgiving weekend, allowing more family time at home.


Membership - "I Want to be an Ardwick" sheet sent out. Follow up calls will be made.
