ARDWICK BOARD MEETING

October 13, 1990

Present: Babcock, Bruce, Conner, Hill, MacIntosh, McKay, Patterson, Smith

President Hill opened the meeting, which was held at the Ardsley Country Club, at 10:30 am.

The minutes of the meeting of May 1 had been mailed to the board members and were accepted, after typographical corrections, plus a correction on page 3, third paragraph from the bottom. The promotion and public relations committees referred to here come under the USWCA, not the Senior Bonspiel.

The treasurer's report was accepted as presented. Jean Glus and Doris Garrison had completed an audit of the treasurer's records during the summer.

Mrs. McKay reviewed the names of our prospective curlers and emphasized our need for more members.

Bonspiels: Mrs. Hill reported for Kathy Mudge on the three invitations we have received:

Broomstones: the weekend of Dec. 7-9 - invitation to be forwarded to the evening curlers.

Rochester: a weekend, bed & breakfast of shopping and curling - invitation to be forwarded to the evening curlers.

Royal Montreal to be held in November.

Three Brooms - Anita Mayhew is in charge from Nutmeg. Our turn as host club will be here Friday morning, Dec. 7; the club will be open for lunch. We will go to Darian on March 1. The Nutmeg ladies cannot get evening ice time for the Three Broom competition, so their turn will be held here but they will supply the refreshments. Helena Crowley and Anita will set the date.

Shirley Bruce and Jill Owens discussed the level of competition that should occur at the Three Brooms. They both felt that it should be competitive, but Jill agreed that using it as a practice for the championship teams was over doing it.

Ardwick Pins: Shirley Bruce had a sample of the pin as we had ordered it. The board agreed with the decision to change the color of the outside circle and the stone to a lighter blue. The pins will cost us \$1.26; we will sell them for \$3.00.

Membership: Jean MacIntosh understands that Suad Barghout will be bringing a friend to try curling.

Hospitality & House Chairman: Bobbie Patterson reported that she, Trish and Jinny had begun work on the Ladies Room. (The Curling Board ok'd \$100 toward the project.) They have painted it an off white, a new blue rug is installed, it will have a blue border to match. She now has to replenish the paper supplies. The Club's summer camp left a mess for us to clean up.

Publicity: Jinny Hill reported that Jean Glus has been sending notices of the board meetings to the local papers.

Nominating: Carol Meszaros' committee consists of Bobbie Patterson, Shirley Bruce, Betty Steinemann, and Margaret Murdock.

USWCA: Shirley Bruce reported for Marcella Hanlon

The Scots Tour now plans to curl here on Thursday, Jan 31, using two sheets of ice in the morning, then immediately leaving for Nutmeg (with whoever plays against them) for lunch. This also means, must have a gift for them.

At the June meeting the USCA passed, in principle, as did the ladies the joining of the two groups.

President Hill opened the meeting, held in the Warm Room, at noon.

The minutes of the meeting of October 13 were accepted as presented.

The treasurers report was presented. Jinny Hill reported that the redecoration of the ladies room cost \$217; the board gave us \$100. She had spent \$54 for curtains for the club which should come from the Ardsley Curling Club, not from the Ardwick funds.
