BONSPIEL CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

September 24, 1991

Anita Mayhew, 3 Brooms Chairman, Nutmeg, and I have tentatively, and with the approval of both Boards, set the three dates for the 3 Brooms competition as follows:

- ? February 13, 1992 " " a Thurs. p.m.  
to be hosted by the Candlewicks
- March 6, 1992, at Nutmeg, a Friday

However, Jill Owens, President of Nutmeg Ladies spoke to me in August, and asked that I ask the Ardwicks Board if they would consider changing the 3 Brooms to only two competitions during the year, one for the day curlers and one for the night curlers. Apparently she has broached this with the Nutmeg curlers, with no vote taken as yet.

Anita and I discussed this and both of us feel that this would not be a particularly good change, but this is certainly something that should be discussed at today's meeting. We went ahead and set the three dates as at the present time it is still a three event competition.

To date I have received no bonspiel invitations.

ARDWICK BOARD MEETING

September 25, 1991

Present: Bruce, Cowles, Glus, Hanlon, Hill, MacIntosh, McKay, Meszaros, Patterson and Smith

President Hill opened the meeting, held at her home, at 10 am.

A letter was read from Sloan-Kettering, thanking us for contribution in Marie Jacobs' memory.

Minutes of the April 13, 1991 meeting were read. Shirley Bruce noted, under Bonspiels, trophy order for Empire State will be Utica, 2nd and Schenectady, 4th, rather than the reverse. In same paragraph, typo error, finals of the Douglas are Jan. 12. Minutes were accepted as corrected.

Treasurer's Report was accepted as presented. Jinny Hill reported Jan Conner had been concerned about missing pins or funds for sale of same. It was discovered 23 pins were mistakenly billed in the men's book.

Bonspiels: Shirley Bruce presented calendar of 3 Brooms set by her and Anita Mayhew, Nutmeg Chair:

12/ 6/91 - Friday am - at Ardsley  
2/13/92 - Thurs. pm - at Ardsley, hosted by Candlewicks  
3/ 6/92 - Friday am - at Nutmeg

It was noted evening competitions must be held at Ardsley. (Nutmeg is not available.) Jill Owns, Nutmeg Ladies President, has suggested this competition be reduced to 2 competitions annually. After discussion, Jean MacIntosh moved 3 Brooms be left at 3 days, as is. Motion passed. Shirley will send Anita copies of official 3 Brooms forms (scoring sheets, instructions, etc.).

Shirley has received no other Bonspiel invitations.

Rules: Marita Smith said every member should have and read a copy of the Constitution and Bylaws. Archie Bruce will make copies - enough for each member. Marcella Hanlon suggested we use our downstairs bulletin board to post all our notices. A copy of the Constitution and Bylaws will be posted there too. For convenience, information on current events will be posted upstairs.

Marcella said new 1991 Rules of Play has been issued by US Curling Association. Toss out old, undated copies.

Prizes: Carol Meszaros announced the Curling Board has paid for Wells Wicks pins. She has 4 senior pins left. She will be ordering pins needed for this year's competitions.

Marcella noted the wearing of USWCA pins is being encouraged. Shirley said USWCA has bumper stickers for sale.

Skips Rep: Bobbie Patterson said teams will have to be made up for 3 Brooms and Empire State. For the latter (2 teams), a day and a night team were suggested. It was noted Skips must select 2 members for the Nominating Committee - one being a Skip and the other from the General Membership. They should be selected before the Fall Luncheon (November 8th).

Dues for '91-'92 are as follows: Candlewicks - \$150., Day Ladies - \$330. and were determined at the September 17th Curling Board Meeting.

MSWCA: Marcella Hanlon and Shirley Bruce will be going to the meeting in Virginia, MN October 3-6. Air fare of one of Rep. Hanlon's 2 trips to Minnesota will be reimbursed by Ardwicks this year. She will submit a bill at the end of the curling season. Shirley still needs to be reimbursed for expenses incurred on 1 trip last year. She will submit a bill. Determining which Rep. expenses will be reimbursed should be reviewed each curling year.

Publicity: Jean Glus will submit 3 Brooms information to newspapers.

She will send a letter to all Ardwicks, Regular and Associate, requesting membership renewal, curling expectations for this season (days available, etc.). All members will receive a copy of the membership booklet.

It was suggested that, as had been done by the Wicks, an historical membership file index be set up and kept current. This index would include board positions and dates held by members.

Nominating: Shirley Bruce is the "holdover" on this committee. The board will ask Molly Babcock and Heather Kenny to also be members.

Candlewicks: Jinny announced Chris Bertchie will chair this group with Helena Crowley's assistance.

Friendlys: Jean MacIntosh suggested having a friendly with Plainfield (NJ) and possibly asking Beaver Dam (LI). We'd have scrambled teams. Dec. 2nd (1st choice) or 9th matches will be pursued by Shirley.

On the Ice: We start curling Oct. 30 and 31.

Sports: Nadja McKay announced the first 2 events, the Clan and the All American, will be scheduled, with the All American being held the day of the week that has the most curlers competing. (Wed. has been the more popular day in recent past.) Teams will be formed when replies are received from Jean's information request.

Nadja has had 2 meetings during which much was accomplished to prepare for the Empire State. She and Carol Meszaros Co-Chair. Sub-committee chairs are in place and they have started their preparations. Heather has written a letter to Paul Mort requesting the facilities be ready for our event Sunday, Jan. 12, even though the Douglas ends that day.

November 8, 1991

Shirley Bruce announced scheduling for the 3 Brooms with Nutmeg. The first match will be at Ardsley, December 6th, a Friday, with lunch at Ardsley Country Club. The second match will be hosted by the Candlewick's, February 13, in the evening. The final match will be March 6th, Friday morning, at Nutmeg.

Bonspiel notices are placed on the bulletin board downstairs. Candlewick's are planning to attend Plainfield and Silver Belles bonspiels, both weekend events.

Marcella Hanlon, our USWCA Representative, displayed "Ask Me About Curling" pins. Shirley Bruce will order 60 pins and they will be distributed at no charge. Marcella also has "US Women's Curling Association" bumper stickers for sale.

Jinny thanked Bobbie Patterson for arranging the lovely luncheon.

ARDWICK BOARD MEETING

November 8, 1991

Present: Bertchie, Bruce, Cowles, Glus, Hanlon, Hill, McKay, Patterson and Smith

President Hill opened the meeting, held at Ardsley Country Club, at 10:45 am.

Minutes of the September 25, 1991 meeting were accepted as read.

Treasurer's Report was accepted as presented. November 1, 1991 balance: \$1,283.01.

Home Sports: There are 29 Ardwicks and 21 Candlewicks. The All American takes place Wednesday mornings and Thursday evenings. The Clan is Thursday mornings. Both events will be 6 weeks. Nadja McKay also reported breakdown of daytime curlers: 12 Wednesdays only, 9 Thursdays only, 8 both days. Our depleted ranks lead Nadja to suggest rethinking the daytime curling scheduling for 1992-93. She suggested offering regular curling 1 day a week and having a second day for a more competitive league or bonspiel league. Chris Bertchie distributed Candlewicks' All American schedule and roster.

Bonspiels: Shirley Bruce reported Diane Muldowney is now the Nutmeg 3 Brooms Chair. Our skips for the December 6 event are Hill, Bruce and Smith and for March 6 - MacIntosh, Keenan and Patterson.

Shirley has posted bonspiel invitations on the downstairs bulletin board. Chris announced Candlewicks has a team going to Silver Belle and possibly Plainfield bonspiels.

Shirley has spoken to Plainfield about having a friendly here Monday, December 2. Competition would start at 10 am. Teams would mix players. There would be 3 4-end games, switching skip and lead halves after each 4 ends. Chris will research small prizes. Bobbie Patterson will oversee food; coffee before 10 am and lunch. (A menu of strada, aspic mold and finger dessert.) Main dish cooks will be reimbursed expenses.

This lead Nadja to note that all should submit bills for expenses incurred for Empire States, with the option of reimbursement if desired. She wants to keep an accurate account of costs.

Constitution and Bylaws will be distributed at today's luncheon. Chris will take copies for the Candlewicks. Jinny Hill wondered if Housekeeping should become a separate committee.

Rules: Marita Smith circulated humorous cartoon reminders of rules which she will post on the bulletin board. Nadja will include curling etiquette and new rules in a handout she is preparing. It was noted Nadja is entitled to be reimbursed for her expenses.

Prizes: Status of Empire States medals and trophies was discussed.

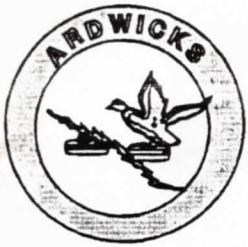
