### *Flame Rules*

- Teams change completely each game, and are made up of available players *including* substitutes.
- Players can play "ranked position", or up or back one position (e.g., leads play lead or second; seconds play lead, second or vice).
- Teams score one point per stone, 2 points per end, and 4 points for the win.
- *Each player* accumulates the entire team's score each time she plays. Substitutes accumulate their own scores.
- Total scores accumulated by individual are divided by the number of games played by individual.
- *One point is deducted from average for each game missed.*
- Individual with highest score in each "ranked position" will win the pin and honor of "Flaming Lead", "Flaming Second", "Flaming Vice" or "Flaming Skip".

February 2, 1994

President McKay opened the meeting, held at the Ardsley Curling Club, at 7:45 pm.

Minutes of the December 11, 1993 meeting were accepted as presented. A thank you note from the President of "New Beginnings" was read expressing appreciation for our donation at Christmastime.

Two Brooms second competition this season will be skipped by Jean MacIntosh, Shirley Bruce and Mary Jean Keenan. Jan Conner is planning a lasagna lunch and will charge \$5 per person. Jinny Hill will score.

Pins - Mary Jean said Chris Bertchie will be consulted to determine needs for evening curlers' pins. Pins are needed for 2 daytime events. Our teams of more than 4 players might cause a shortage of All American pins (although five are supplied). Junior Skips, the last event, will run 3 weeks.

Treasurer's Report was distributed by Jean Glus. Receipts: \$222.91, Disbursements: \$270.93, included USWCA dues and boxes for trophies as big items. Balance at 2/1/94: \$1,644.63. To keep better track of pins in the future, Jean will keep them in her possession (20 were unaccounted for last year and 6 so far this season).

Board Meetings - Nadja noted attendance is part of the responsibility of assuming a committee chairmanship and hopes this will be stressed by the Nominating Committee as they seek a slate.

Bonspiels - It was noted that a committment needs to be met 4 weeks prior to a bonspiel (or as other deadlines dictate) with names and money to substantiate. Guidelines for participation in bonspiels should be posted BOLDLY and STRESSED at opening and closing meetings.

Pull the Plug - March 26th.

Junior Skip Event - A Junior Skip will be asked to chair. Jinny Hill will find someone and assist her.

Empire State - Will be here January, 1995. Jean MacIntosh and Jean Glus graciously volunteered to chair. Our first choice for date: 1/15, second: 1/8 (both Sundays) to start. Shirley will handle rosters and Mary Jean the opening party.

USWCA - Shirley is doing a newsletter. She also showed the "Pal Pin" (the latest), appropriate to be given to men who often curl with women to fill out sheets or given to men helpers - perhaps for the Empire States?



March 22, 1994

Present: Babcock, Bertchie, Bruce, Conner, Cowles, Glus, Keenan, Kenny, MacIntosh and McKay.

President McKay opened the meeting, held at the Ardsley Curling Club, at 12:10 pm.

Minutes of the February 2, 1994 meeting were accepted as presented.

Treasurer's Report - 4 Associate Members have not paid dues for the 1993-94 season. Faith Lundgren will be dropped from the roster. The other 3 will get another notice in the fall and, if no response, be dropped. February receipts: \$104.74, disbursements: \$61.63, balance March 17: \$1,787.74.

Hospitality - Jan Conner thanked Heather Kenny and Nadja McKay for purchasing supplies. Jan should get a shoppers' club card (as Heather and Nadja now have) for Ardsley's membership.

Two Brooms - Heather sadly announced we lost.

Nominating Committee - Molly Babcock announced Lillie Shortridge Baggett will be the 2nd Vice President. It was suggested that the 1st Vice Presidency be divided into 1 representative for the night and 1 for the day curlers and that they try to get a separate chair for each event. Chris Bertchie is nominated for President and we hope she will remain in the area. It was noted that notice of the slate must be distributed 2 weeks before vote, which occurs at the annual meeting (according to the by-laws).
