Nancy Clancy Gudrun Sablow Empire State Bonspiel co- chairs 4.) Ties are to be broken with the play of a full end.

1.) Teams shall not start any game, under any circumstances, with less than four

(4) players.

2.) If at any time during the Bonspiel after registration, a substitute is required to complete a four person team, the substitute(s) may be obtained from the home club of the team involved, time permitting, or from the Host Club. Only two substitutes are allowed on a team during a game and shall be allowed to play in any position at the discretion of the Skip. A minimum of two (2) curlers from the regular team must be present to play or the game will be declared a forfeit.

3.) Any team which chooses to forfeit a game without consulting the Bonspiel Chair and exhausting all possibilities for substitutions will be declared ineligible to continue to compete in the bonspiel.

4.) When during a game, a player is unable to continue because if illness, accident or any other valid reason, the team to which she belongs may:

 Finish the game with the remaining three players, in which case the first two players shall deliver three stones each, or

Bring in any qualified substitute for the remainder of the game.
 At the start of any subsequent game there must be four players on the team.

5.) A player who has left the game because of illness, accident or any valid reason, may rejoin her team any time during that game unless a substitute has been put in her place on the team.

6.) No substitute sweepers are allowed.

G. Scoring:

F. Substitutions:

Vice Skips (3's) will make all measurements to determine scoring stones.

Under certain circumstances, some rules may pose a problem for the Host Club and need to be changed to accommodate the Bonspiel. Rules should not be deviated from without notifying the Host Clubs in advance and getting consensus of opinion.

H. Rules of Play:

This bonspiel shall be governed by the current USCA rules as posted, unless superseded by a rule above.

### EMPIRE STATE BONSPIEL RULES

All games shall be played under the current WCF (World Curling Federation) Rules of Play as they have been adopted by the USCA and current GNCC rules with the following exceptions and/or additions. A rulebook must be posted during play, local rules to be included in the Bonspiel kit. The Bonspiel shall take place annually the third (3<sup>rd</sup>) weekend in January.

A. Eligibility:

Any curler who is a member in-good-standing of a Curling Club is eligible to curl in the Empire State Bonspiel.

B. Order of Acceptance:

- 1.) Two (2) teams from each Host Club. Note: A team cannot be entered under the name of a Host Club unless they are involved in the Host Club's playdowns and designated to fill one of the guaranteed slots for each Host Club or have been designated by their Club's) to enter the event in the Club's name or have been asked by the Host Club's) to enter a team to fill the Bonsoiel.
- 2.) Any Team that includes Charlene Fitzgerald (not included in Schenectady's

two entries)

3.) The winning team from previous year.

4.) All team members from the same Curling Club.

5.) Composite teams that meet the eligibility rule. (1st-come/1st-registered/1st-

pay basis.

6.) Teams entering in the name of a Paper Club that meet the eligibility rule (1st-come/1st-registered/1st-pay basis).

7.) Additional teams from the Host club will be accepted. (see Eligibility.

Guidelines #5)

C. The Team:

A team must have the full complement of four (4) eligible players who register at the Bonspiel site. Leads will toss for last rock. A fifth (5th person will be allowed to register on a team. That fifth (5th) will pay an additional 25% of registration fee and be eligible to receive the Empire State medal along with the others.

D. Rotation of Players:

A change in team line up must be submitted at least 15 minutes prior to the next game.

E. Time Limit:

- 1.) All games will be eight (8) ends, including the finals.
- 2.) The bell will be rung at the start of each draw and any team not ready to play shall forfeit one point and one end for each full 15 minutes of delay. At the end of 60 minutes the game will be declared a forfeit.
- 3.) Games will not be timed. Skips shall be responsible for insuring that play proceeds with all reasonable speed. It is expected that an eight end game will take no more than two hours to complete. When slow play is idealt field (one end behind other play), a member of the host committee can warm both teams and request they speed up play. If any team is warmed in two different games, a vote by two representatives of Empire State Bonspiel Committee shall be taken to determine if the second game will be declared a forfeit. The voting members in this decision must be from two different clubs and not by a club whose team is playing in the game in question.




