

EMPIRE STATE BONSPIEL ANNUAL MEETING
January 12, 1992

Nadja McKay presided over and called the meeting to order at 8:30 pm at the home of Marcella Hanlon of the Ardwick's. Present were:

Last year's minutes were reviewed and approved. Carol stated that the Utica Glengarries, as next year's host, had held a general meeting at which time a motion was passed to hold the '93 Empire State Bonspiel over a weekend, with the welcoming party to be held on a Thursday PM. She presented us with a choice of weekends, Friday, Saturday, Sunday January 8,9, and 10 or January 22,23, and 24. Shirley Bruce said that she though the later dates would conflict with the USWCA Senior Bonspiel which she though would be the 17th through the 20th and would not be beneficial for either bonspiel. The consensus was that January 8,9,10 would probably be preferable. Schenectady and Ardwick's to discuss and inform Utica as soon as possible of their decisions. It was also agreed that this would not set a precedent or the other host clubs.

At last year's meeting it had been decided for the awarding of the four event trophies and medals, that Utica and Schenectady always be separated by the Ardsley and Westchester Wicks. All agreed this year that this sequence would not work. Shirley agreed to work out a rotation for awards.

Nadja suggested that the travelling box contain only the previous three years of ESB files, a home to be found for all files before this time, with a card file to be kept as to who has what and where. All agreed and offered to work on this.

All the picture books will circulate and be kept up. There is one picture missing which Marie will try to find. Marcella is working on the albums now.

For the winners sheet that is updated every year we agreed that it should not only list the year and winning team but also the host club for that year.

We discussed the supply of ESB award pins for the 1st event and they will have to be ordered in '94 or '95. Marie will take care of this.

Utica mentioned that they have just ordered club pins from a new supplier who does not use a die but makes them by copying one of their present pins, and are therefore cheaper. Utica will report on the quality and price of pins when they receive their order.

Marie Pletenik will send a copy of the 1st and 2nd set of "guidelines" to Shirley Bruce, to be included in the front of the travelling book and so that she may update and include the rotation of awards.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 9:15 pm.
