44th Empire State Bonspiel Final Report Ardsley Curling Club, Ardsley-on-Hudson

The Ardwicks Curling Club, Ardsley Country Club, Ardsley-on-Hudson, N.Y., were the hosts of the 44th Empire State Bonspiel held on January 8-11, 1998. Mary Jean Keenan and Jean Murphy were co-chairmen.

Eighty invitations were sent to all women's clubs throughout the U.S. and Canada (see list) on November 1, 1997 by Jean Murphy seeking invited participants to respond by December 18 to Mary Jean Keenan. Personal invitations were also extended to some Canadian curlers. The applicants were asked to include a check for their team in the amount of \$240.00. Canadian teams were asked to send their money in U.S. funds to save the Ardwicks from incurring any bank charges in the monetary exchange -- New York money changing fees are significant. The reasoning behind the 80 invitations being sent is that we were hoping to attract a few teams from outside the GNCC and our "local" Canadian area to "The Big Apple". Letters of verification of entry were sent to each team that had been accepted to play in the bonspiel by Mary Jean Keenan. Requests for later draw times on Friday, January 9, were honored.

All committees were appointed, maps, goodie bags and the draws were all set to go on Thursday evening, January 8. Heather and Brian Kenny graciously lent their house in Ardsley Park for the opening reception. Almost all of the 14 teams attended the social gathering. Heather, Reception Chairman, and her committee served and elegant buffet which included hors d'oeuvres, ham, turkey and many other wonderful dishes. The evening included an open bar of wine, soda and cocktails.

On Friday evening, Mary Jean Keenan arranged for the dinner to be held at the Ardsley Country Club. The dinner was highlighted with a performance by The Hudson Bells. Mary Jean, a long time member of the Ardsley Country Club, also gave an extremely interesting history of the origins of the main building of the Ardsley Country Club during the dinner.

The Saturday dinner was held at the Ardsley Curling Club. This was organized so that all the participants in the bospiel could take some time to chat with other curlers while having a chance to see some great matches being played. Mitzi Wang, Laureen Paul and Pam Siebert provided a wonderful filet mignon dinner.

Arrangements were made for the curlers to stay at four of the local hotels. The Marriott Courtyard in Tarrytown, N.Y. gave us the best rate at \$59.00 per night (their standing rate is usually \$134.00/weekday).

The draw for 14 teams was designed so that every team could play two games on Friday. Only one team had to play back-to-back on Saturday. We had great matches the whole weekend with some scores being closer than others. The Fourth PlaceFinal competition was played at 9:30 a.m. Sunday morning and the First, Second and Third Place Finals were piped on the ice at 1:00 p.m. with a roomful of well wishers applauding the warm room.

Prizes and trophies were displayed by Mary Jean Keenan. Jean Murphy and Mary Jean Keenan presented the trophies at the awards ceremony immediately following the final matches.



Mary Jean Keenan chaired the meeting, which was held during the opening party of the bonspiel at the home of Heather and Brian Kenny. It began at 7:30

Minutes of the 1/23/97 meeting were reviewed. Joyce Shaffer questioned "Open items #7." saying she is not historian of GNCC nor has she completed a questionaire on the ESB for GNCC."

St. Catharines - This is the correct spelling.

Empire State Plaque - It is the responsibility of the defending champion to bring the plaque to the next year's bonspiel.

<u>Player Eligibility</u> - It should be noted on future invitations that Empire State participants are expected to be dues paying members of a curling club.

Medals - Robbie Trosset had prepared a progress report for distribution at this meeting (copy attached). Joyce reported that Bastian finally has responded, being told we need the pins NOW! Joyce was told that UPS would deliver them tomorrow.(1/9). Reconvening to decide on options was proposed.
